In this week's Update, the Board (Pastor and Deacons) would like to keep you up to speed on some of the repairs and cleaning which were done recently at the Church.




CATHEDRAL GLASS (STAINED GLASS) REPAIRED

On December 10, 2024, an anonymous donor paid for the repairs of the stained-glass on the Church steeple. Prior to this repair, one large pane of glass was damaged creating an empty space which was left unattended for many years. This large space permitted cold air to flow into the balcony of the Church.



OLD BOILER TANK WITH RUST REPLACED

On January 18, 2025, one of the two boiler tanks in the furnace room was removed and replaced with a new tank. This work needed to be done as soon as possible. We praise God for those who contributed their time and other means to ensure that this task was completed.



NORTH EAST (LOWER INSIDE) CORNER OF LAKESIDE ENTRANCE

The lower inside corner at the entrance on Lakeside Road was plastered with cement. Prior to the repair, you might have noticed a hole in the wall close to the pipeline.
